Assessment of attainment of POs and COs

STUDENTS EXIT FEEDBACK

In strict compliance with the objectives of Outcome Based Education (OBE), one of the key performance indicators of the institution is the outcome of the programs offered (POs) and course thought (COs). As the college is affiliated with Bharathiar University, it takes meticulous care to follow the POs and COs framed by the experts on the board of studies of the university. The POs and COs are displayed on the website and brochure of the college.

Apart from POs and COs mentioned by the university, the institution also has framed POs and COs by introducing additional certificates and value-added courses. The certificate and value-added courses are designed based on the industry requirement and consultation with HR and industry experts.

Methods of Implementation

At the initial level, the discussion takes place with the academic advisory body including the principal, dean of academics, IQAC, and heads of various departments on the POs and COs framed by the university. In addition to university-prescribed POs and COs, the academic advisory body will recommend institutional-level POs and COs. The body of department heads, teachers, and invited domain experts will frame the department-level POs and COs. Once the POs and COs are framed, the same will be shared with teachers at the beginning of the academic year as a part of the faculty development program.

The admission officer of the college and teaching staff counselors who are engaged in the admission process explain the POs to the students in a detailed prospectus. The same will be well-explained to parents and students together in the inaugural ceremony of the first year. In addition to that, the COs will be explained to the students during their induction program.

One of the important methods of assessing POs and COs is student exit feedback on Graduate Attributes that are essentially earned by each student. A detailed questionnaire is shared among the student on the following aspects for the same:

1. Subject Knowledge
2. Reading Habit
3. Technical Skill
4. Extra-Curricular Skills and Capacities
5. Changes in Character and Attitude

6. Confidence Level
7. Social Commitment
8. Friends and Academic/Career Connections
9. Employability Skills

The responses are measured as 'No Change', 'Improved', and 'Exceptionally Improved'. The data were collected from the pass-out students and analyzed. Based on the responses, actions were taken in order to strengthen the graduate attributes. The summary of the survey responses is as follows.

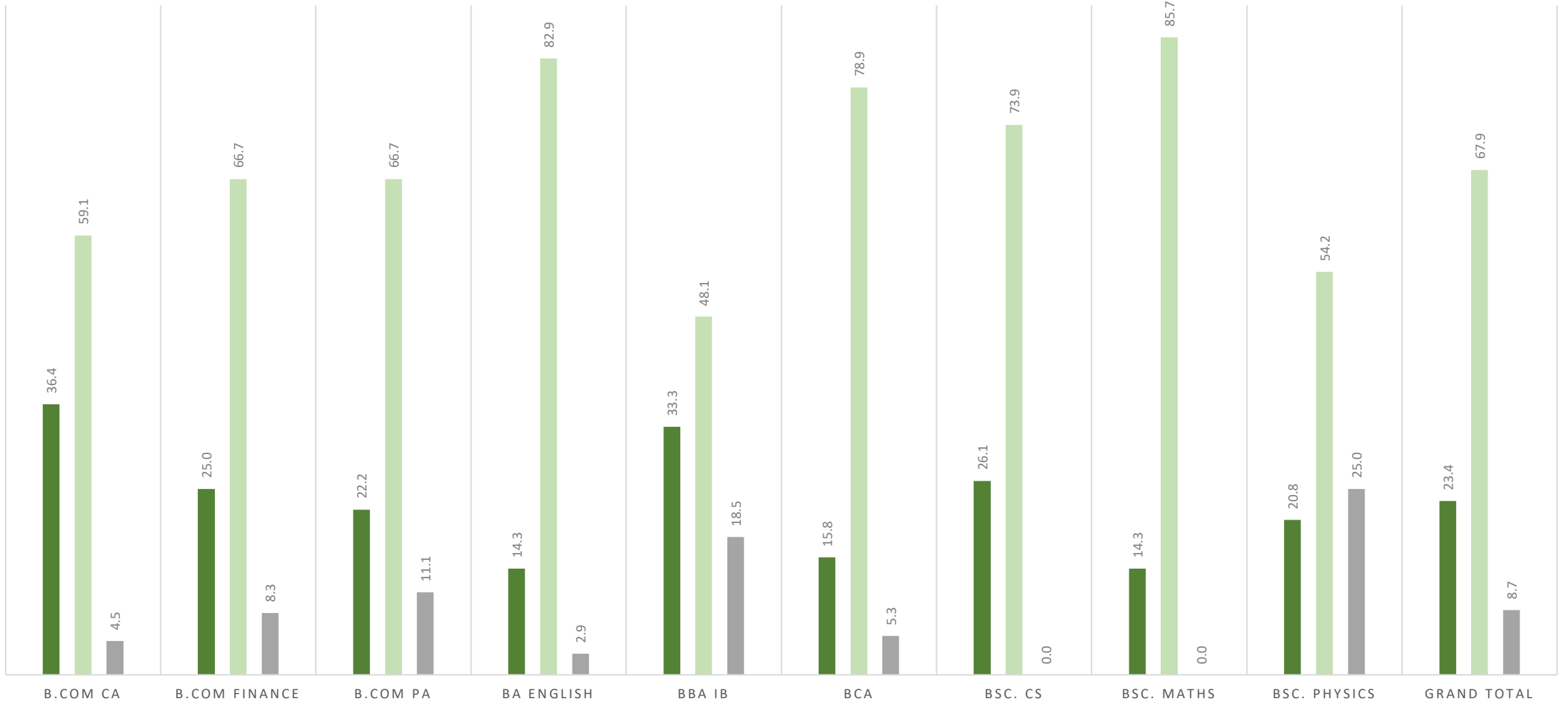

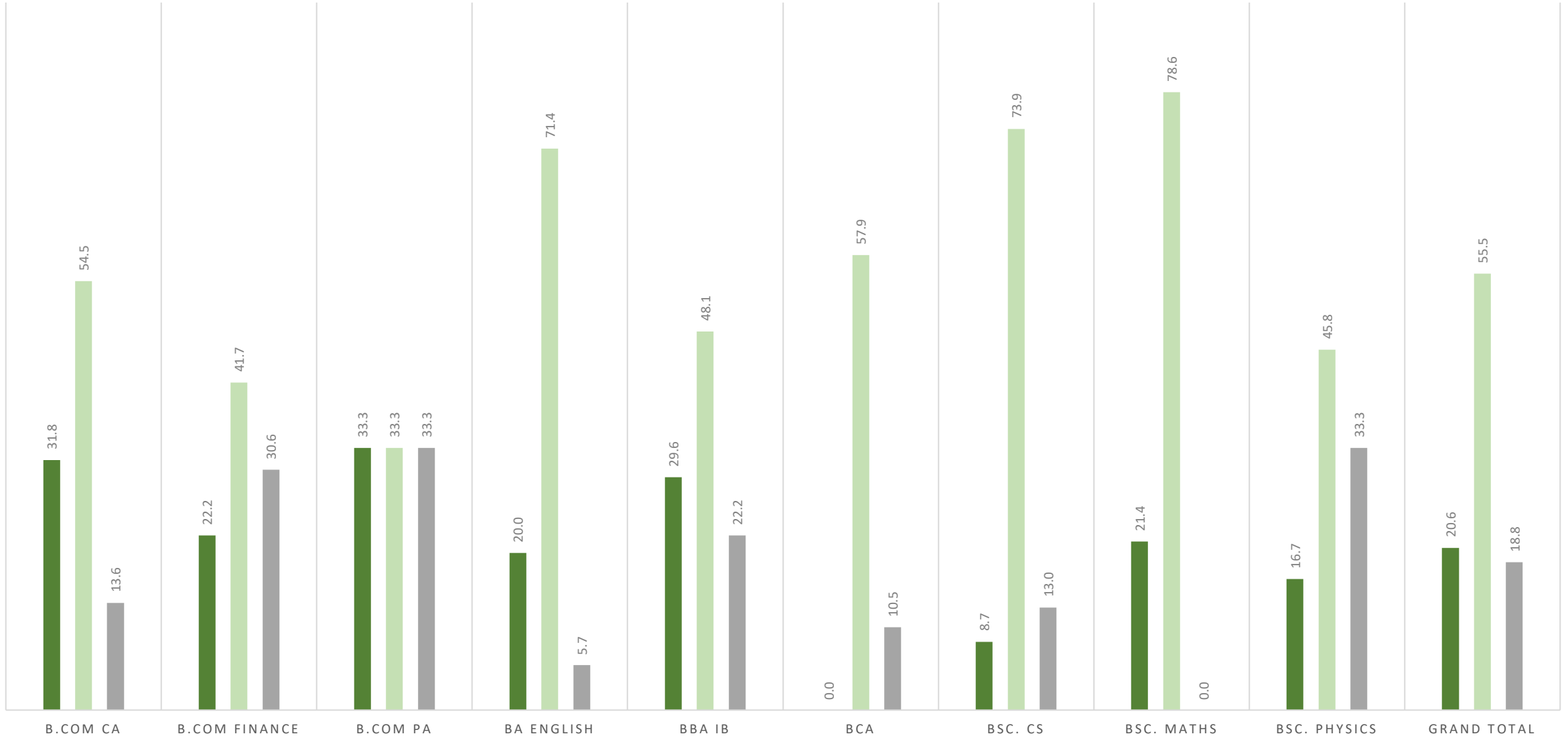
SUBJECT KNOWLEDGE OF THE STUDENTS

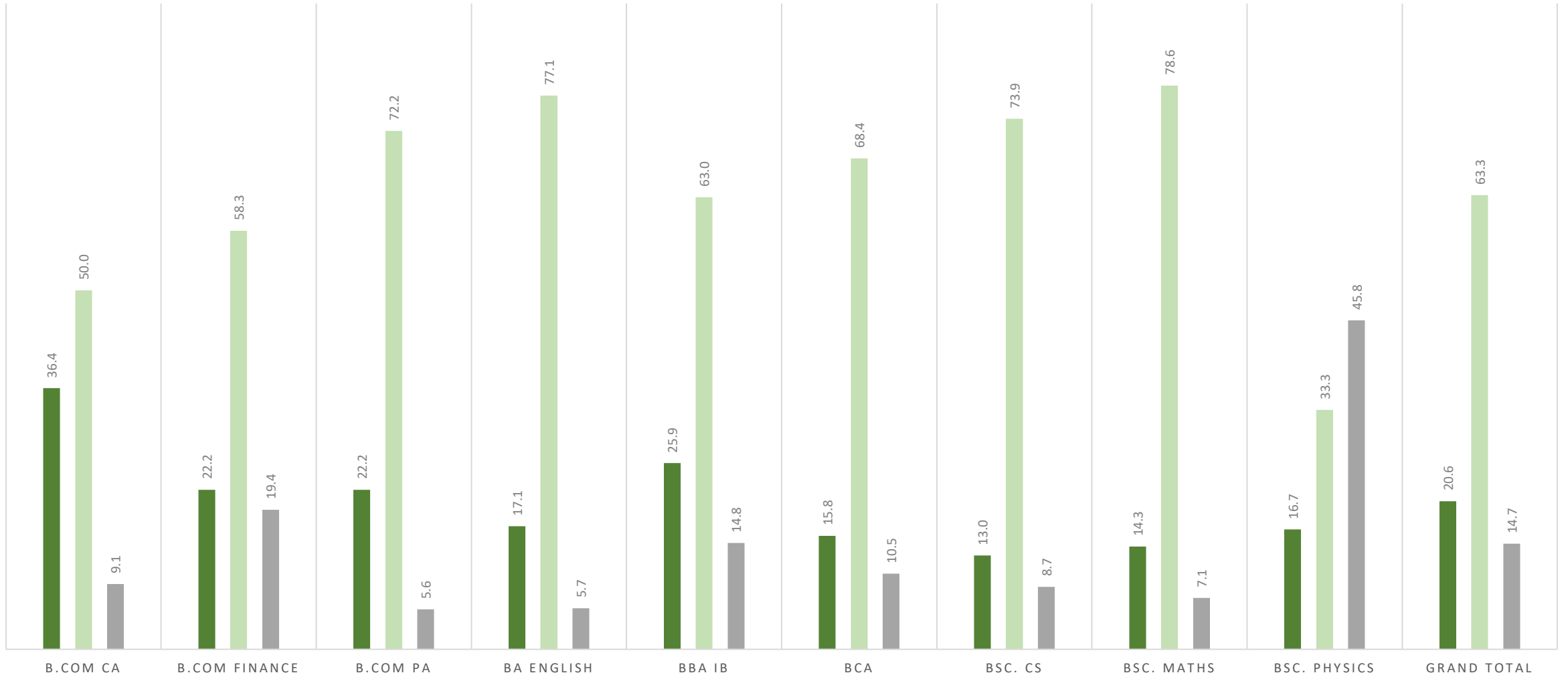
READING HABIT OF THE STUDENTS

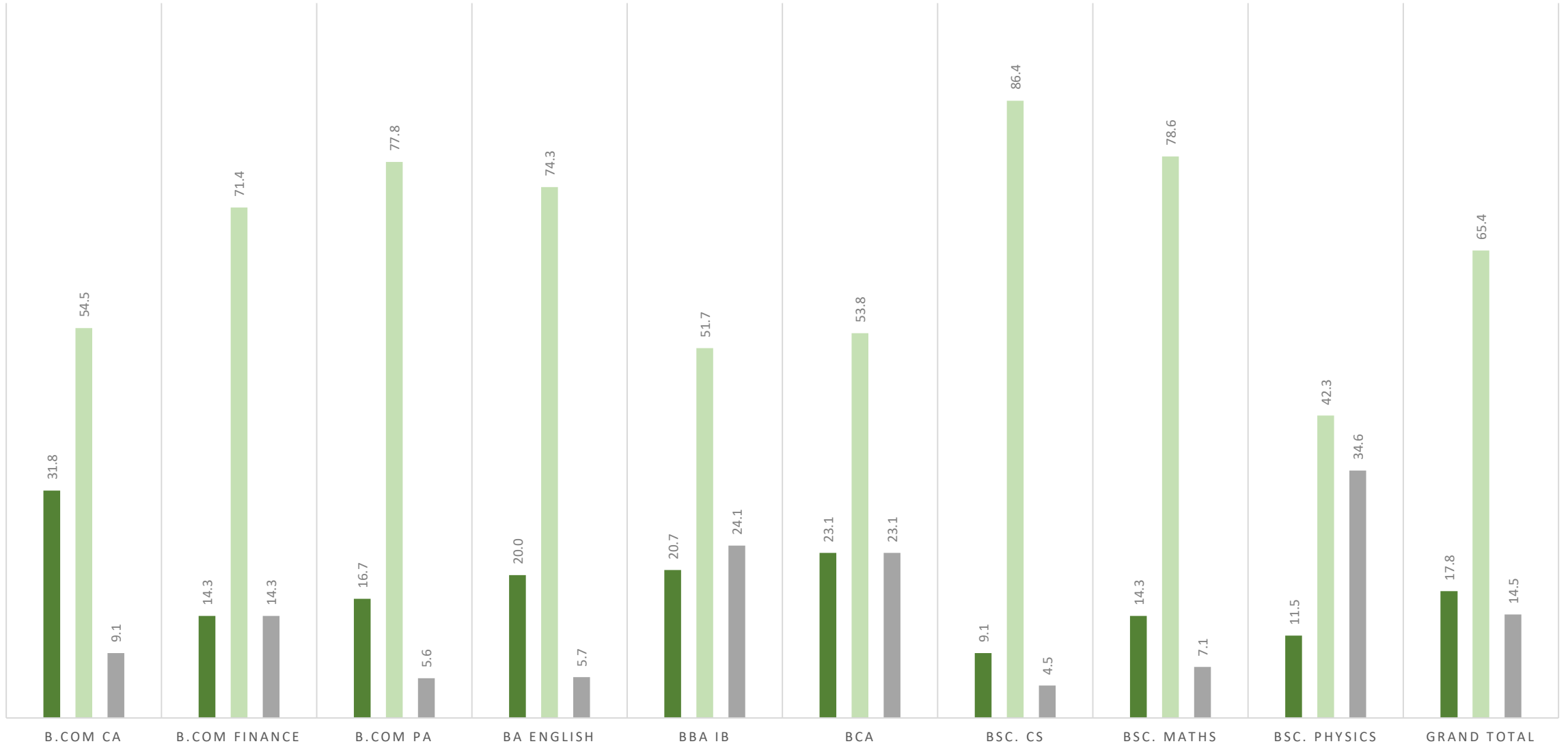
TECHNICAL SKILL OF THE STUDENTS

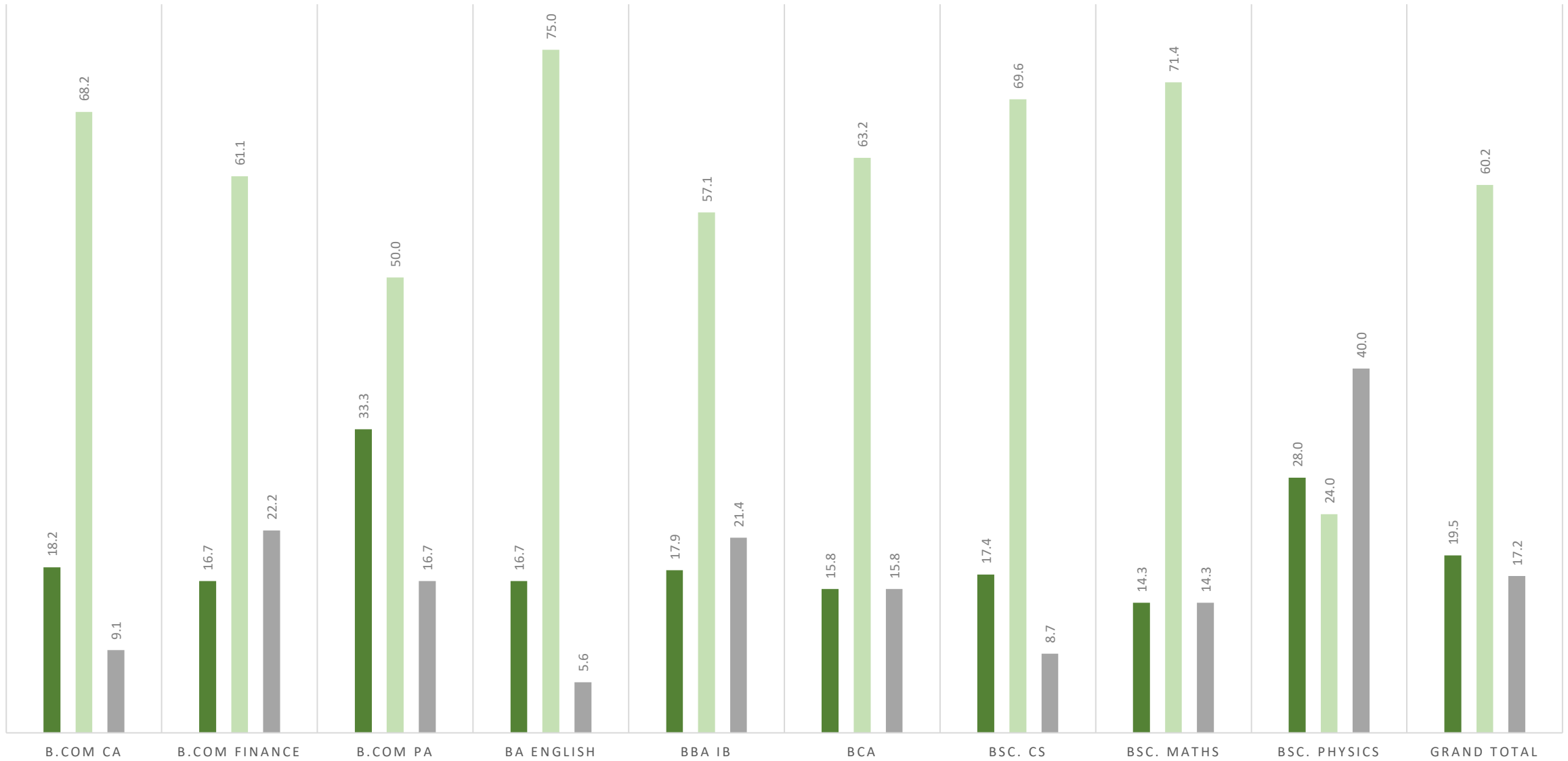
EXTRA CURRICULAR SKILLS AND CAPACITIES OF THE STUDENTS

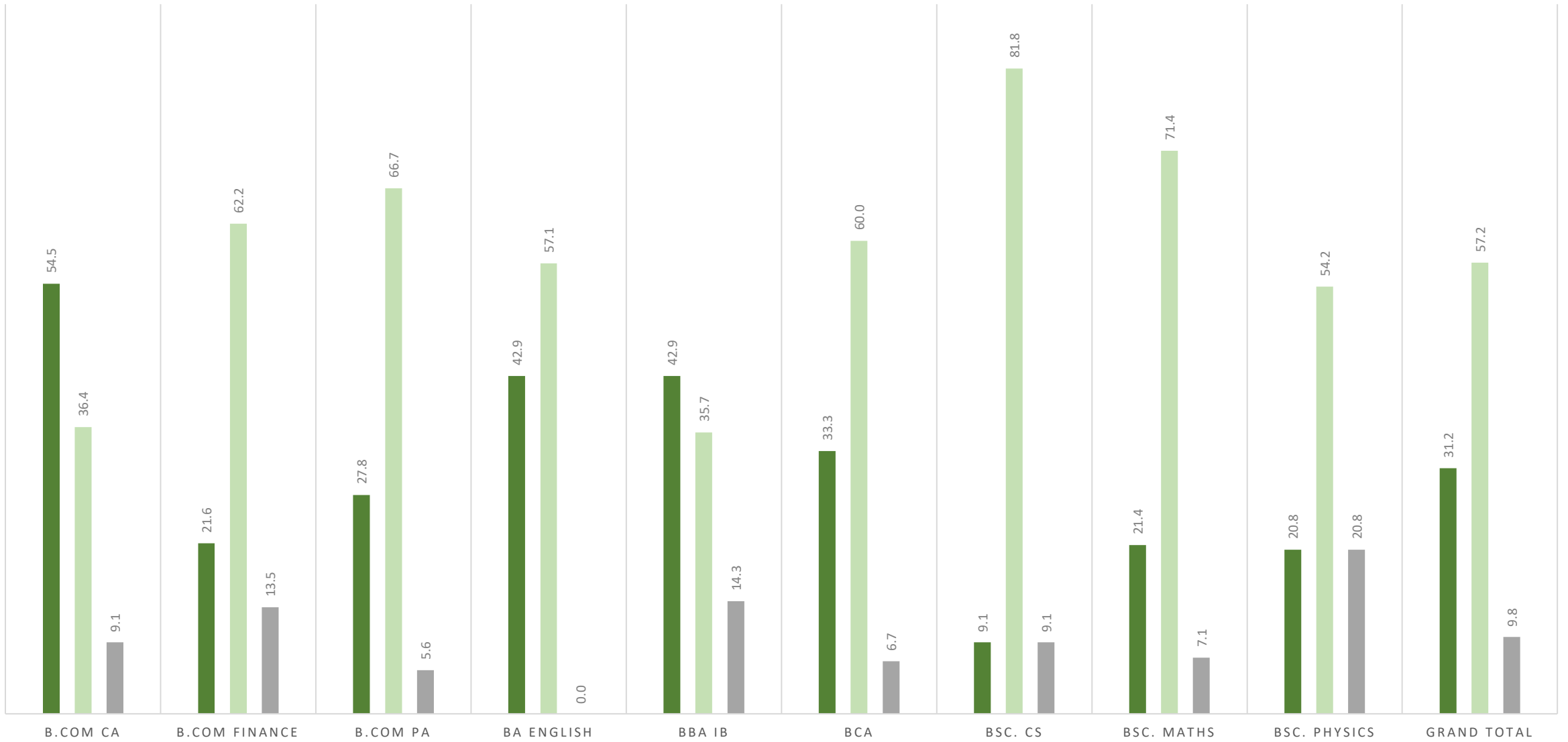
EXTRA CURRICULAR SKILLS AND CAPACITIES OF THE STUDENTS

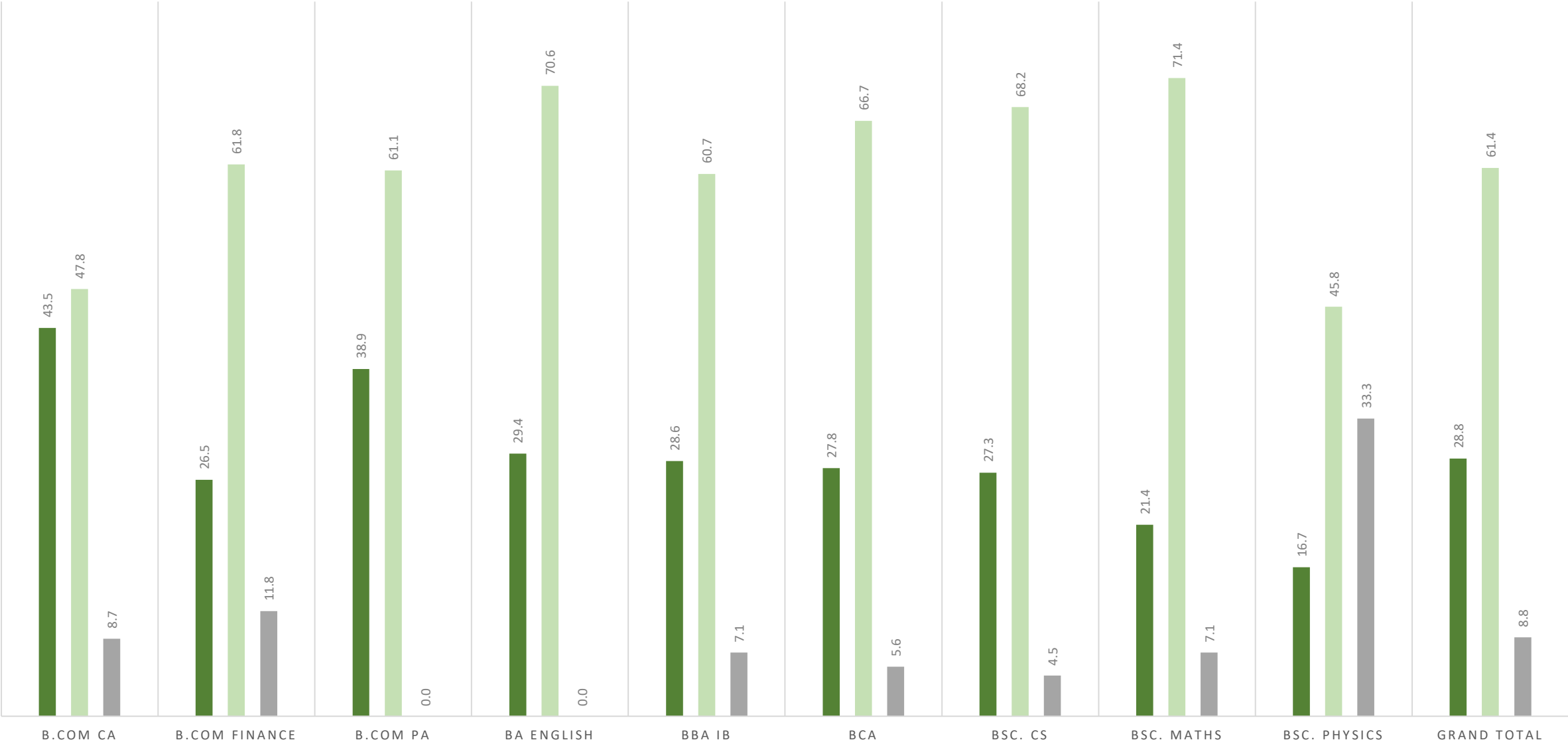
CHARACTER AND ATTITUDE OF THE STUDENTS

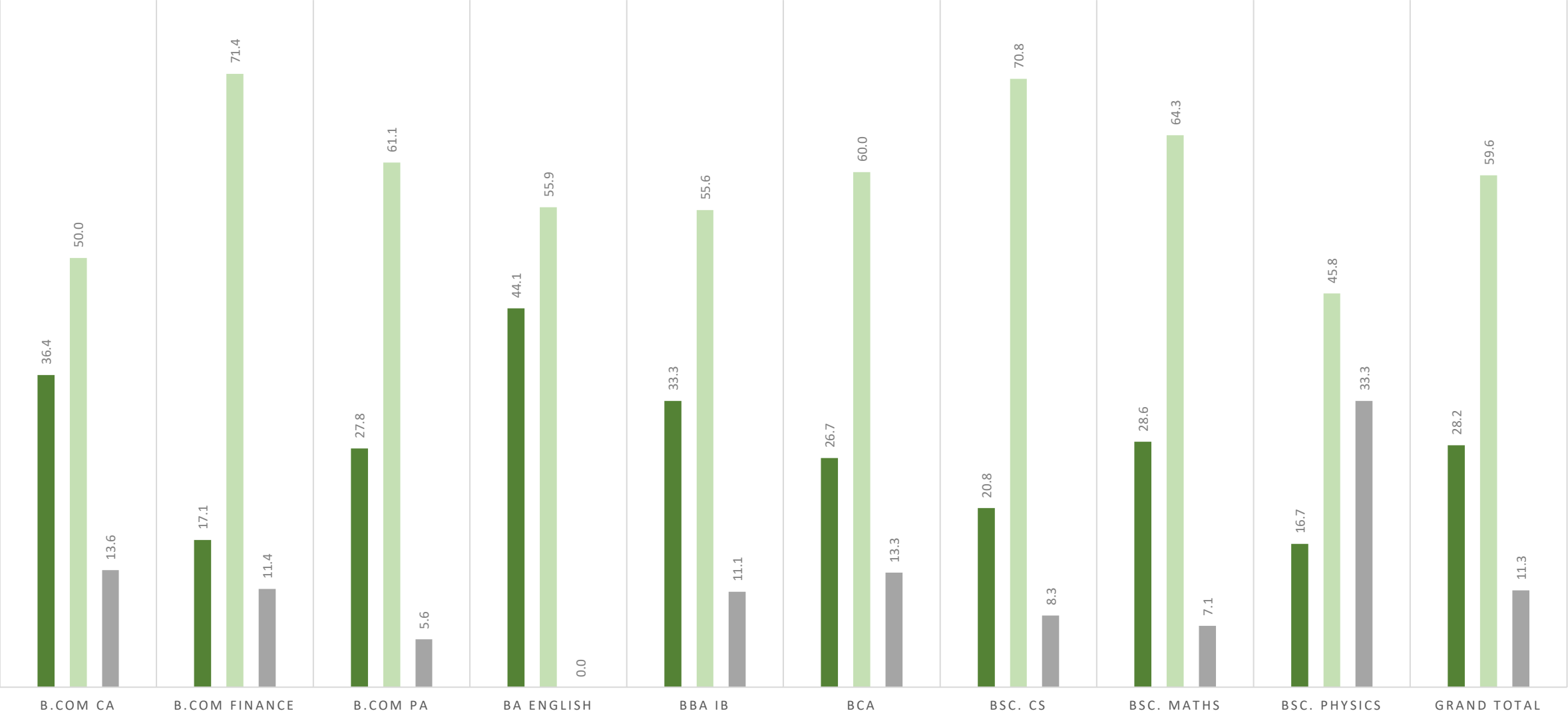
CONFIDENCE LEVEL OF THE STUDENTS

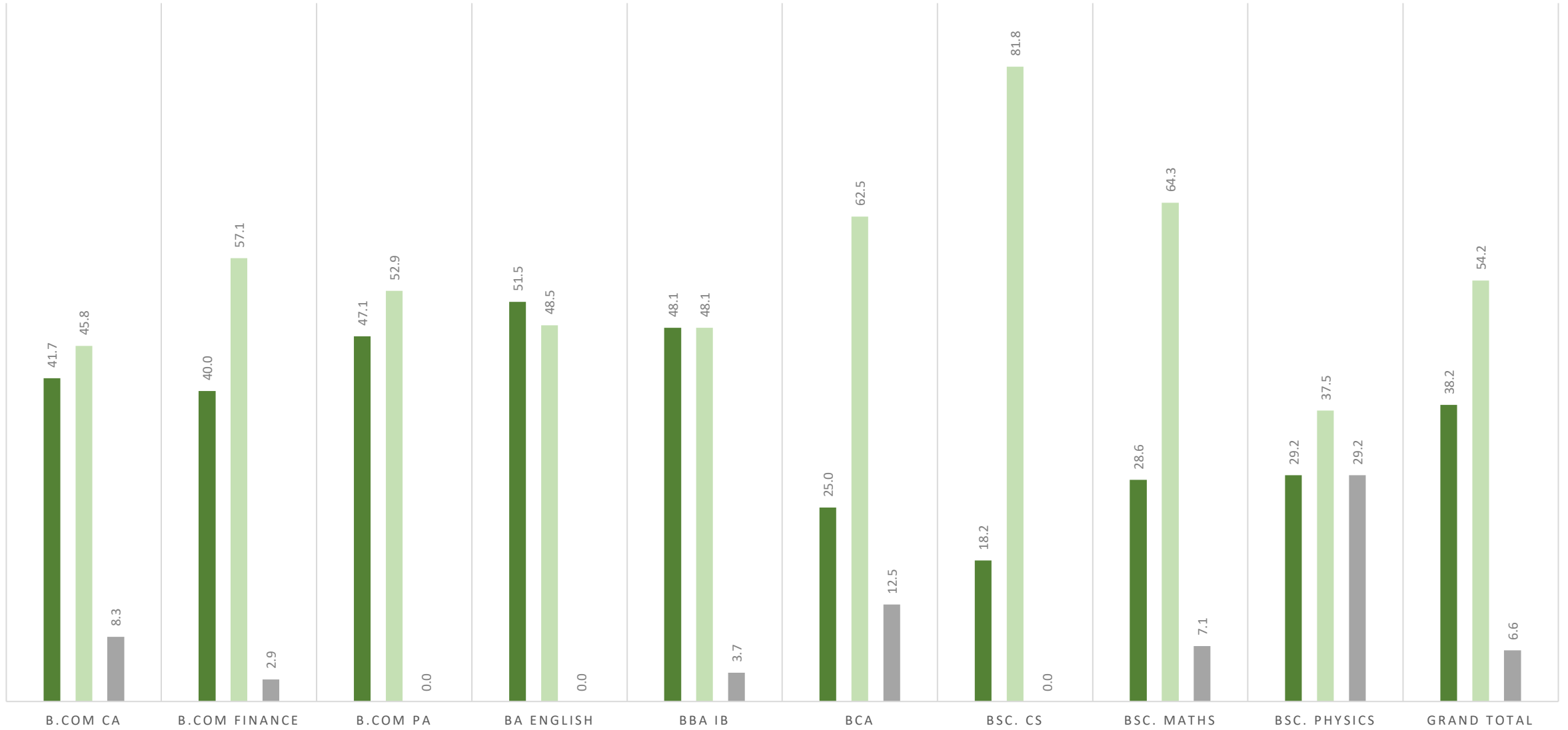
SOCIAL COMMITMENT OF THE STUDENTS
